enum DaysOfWeek {  
    Monday,  
    Tuesday,  
    Wednesday,  
    Thursday,  
    Friday,  
    Saturday,  
    Sunday  
}
```

// Example usage:

let today: DaysOfWeek = DaysOfWeek.Wednesday;
```
